This form allows districts to submit their request for Ohio Math Corps (OMC) Members to serve in their buildings during the upcoming school year. The information in the table below is used to facilitate communication between the OMC program and your district. Box #3 is used to determine the number of Members we will recruit for your district (we will begin recruiting for your district upon receipt of this form). If funding is received for the program, your district will receive *up to* the requested number of OMC Members, based on the availability of qualified applicants, and will contribute match dollars for each Member (see Note below). There are a limited number of Member slots available to fill in each city.

Note: A district contribution of \$4000 is required for each OMC Member. OMC Members will serve a minimum of 900 hours total (approximately 30 hours per week), including at least 90 hours of Professional Development, and must work with a minimum of 10 (ideally 20-30) students in grades K-5 to develop critical math skills. Districts must assign a team leader / coach to each building to mentor the OMC Members, assist with scheduling, and approve timesheets.
